Job Description:

Full-time teaching of weekly Mathematics lessons to grades 5 through 8 delivered through the methods and sequenced content of the Waldorf® curriculum.

Plan and deliver lessons using the Waldorf® Main Lesson methodology.

Full participation in the range of collegial work commitments typical of a full-time faculty member of a Waldorf school including the weekly faculty meetings, working-group and committee meetings, professional development days, mentoring meetings, periodic parent and other one-on-one meetings, and other mandatory attendance days (such as open houses and school festivals).
